and warm clothing, or to fetch much-needed income at the market.

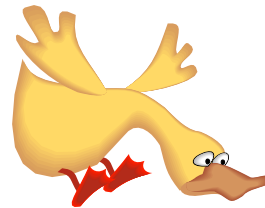
Ducks even produce fertilizer that can dramatically increase crop yields!
